## **CITIZENS CHARTER FOR PEACE AND HARMONY**

### **1. Text Book Content :**

**Examine and authenticate the content in History Text Books for Students at the School and College Levels by appointing a Committee of Respected Historians like Dr. Romilla Thappar, Dr Irfan Habib, Prof Bipin Chandra, Prof. Mushirul Hassan , Prof Ruchira Banerjee , Prof. Shirin Moosavi and other renowned historians .**

### **2. Laws against Hate material :**

**Bring about a law to halt and make punishable hate literature, emails, through print electronic, writing, emails .**

### **3. Creation Meaningful Communal Harmony Programs :**

**Design Television programs for Communal Harmony ; Celebrations of Festivals, Round Tables, Seminars, Art Exhibitions, Music, Sports, Reading of Poetry. An Exchange of knowledge and philosophy between Leaders of different Religious Traditions, sponsored by the Government of India .**

### **4. Table and Pass a strong Bill on “The Prevention of Communal and Targeted Violence (Access to Justice and Reparations) Bill in Parliament” :**

**The Indian Constitution mandates equal respect and opportunities for all people; Freedom of conscience and religion or the freedom of the spirit to respect the rights of others.**

**To respect, protect and fulfill the right to equality before the law and equal protection of law by imposing duties on the Central Government and the State Governments, to exercise their powers in an impartial and non-discriminatory manner to prevent and control targeted violence, including mass violence, against Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, religious and ethnic Minorities , women and children in any State in the Union of India, and linguistic minorities in any State in the Union of India; to thereby uphold secular democracy; to help secure fair and equal access to justice and protection to these vulnerable groups through effective provisions for investigation,**

**prosecution and trial of offences under the Act; to provide for restorative relief and reparation, including rehabilitation and compensation to all persons affected by communal and targeted violence; and for matters connected herewith and incidental thereto.**
